Introduce Pop Art and the life of Andy Warhol - Youtube

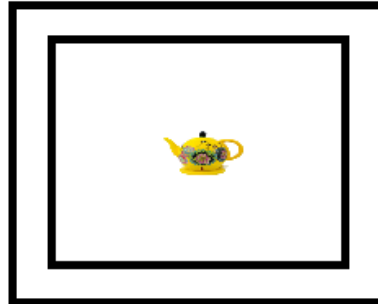

Talk about the fact that Andy used everyday objects to take photos which were then taken as pieces of Art work. He took good photos. What makes a good photo. Look at these photos. What is the matter with them?



Cut out a cardboard frame about 10cm by 10cm and use it to frame something in the room and practise



drawing it.

You could do a close up of the object or a long view. Think about which one looks the best.

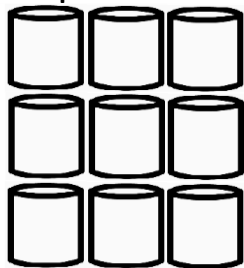
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Lesson 2 Remind pupils about the work and life of Andy Warhol - powerpoint.  
Talk about the fact that Andy used everyday objects to take photos which were then taken as pieces of Art work. He took good photos. Look at the famous soup can picture.



Check it out on the internet.

We are going to make our own version of this picture. Choose a tin can of food from your cupboard. Now you need to draw the outline shape of the can nine times like this. There is a template at the end if you can print.



Now you draw your own can nine times and you can use what ever colours you like. Make each can look different just like Andy Warhol did.

Lesson 3 Remind children about the work of Andy Warhol. Remind children what makes a good photo and that once we have taken the photo we can change it on the computer. How you can change the photo you have taken will depend on the software you are using. Take some photos, check that the object is in the centre and has good lighting. Now try and change the colours of the photo in your editing section. Make sure you save your changed photos.

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	You can take photos as a background on Purple Mash 2Paint and you can then then colour over the objects in the photo to change them.
Lesson 4	Demonstrate how to use the collage app on Purple Mash. Go into 2Paintapicture and then choose eCollage. You can take a photo of an object and then change the colours and add it to the main page. Make a collage in the theme of Andy Warhol.
Lesson 5	To take this unit further the children will put photos into a sequence to make a short film using Purple Mash 2Animate (in the Art section). You will need to think of a story and use your toys to be the charcters e.g The Three little pigs could be played by 2 teddies and a doll and you could make the houses out of boxes and sticks etc. Put the characters into their positions and take a photo. In the next slide just move the characters a bit so it looks like they are moving when you play the sequence back. Try and tell a story. Have fun.
