Punctuation = capital letters, full stops, question mark, commas, apostrophes


Conjunctions = and, but, because, then, so, if, when, with - choose appropriate one

Try and write at least 6 sentences each week. Some of them will be short sentences so you could write more.

**Week 1**

Later I proclaim that I like to **skip** and **hop** but not **jump** and I always do it **carefully**.

Finally I report that I am good at writing in my **book** although I could get even better.

**Week 3**

Get off the **chair** **carefully** before you fall.

Get up off the **floor** **quickly** and do ten star **jumps**.

**Week 4**

Command
