

Resources for Worship.

I have put together this folder of Collective Worship based resources that your child might like to look at. Please don't feel that you need to print the resources as they can all be drawn yourselves or by the children.

We always start and end Worship by listening to a piece of calming/peaceful music or a piece of music we like. We talk about the music before moving on to setting up the Worship table.

I have included a picture of our Worship table so that the children can make their own Worship table resources which they can layout each day.



Perhaps you could decorate a box to keep your special objects together. If you do not have a Bible you could fold a piece of paper together and write the word "Bible" on the front and draw some of your favourite Bible story pictures. You could make three candles out of card and draw pretend flames on them. Perhaps the flames could be detachable. A cross can be made by tying two sticks together and putting it in a lump of plasticine to make it stand up. I have enclosed the words that we use to set up the Worship table and to put it away. I have also included a copy of the Worship welcoming dice that we use. You could make this up using the template, draw around 6 squares to make a template or write out the words and stick them on to a dice you already have (I think you'd need a biggish dice!).

I have also included our four "Dobe Value Kites" under a rainbow that can be coloured in and displayed or drawn yourself. There is also a chart that can be filled in each time your child demonstrates a "Dobe Value".

I have also included a copy of the version of "The Lords Prayer" which we use, "The Grace" that we say after we have closed the Worship box and the Schools Diamond Rules. And lastly there is a Flying High tag line to colour in which includes the longer version which is always displayed in school.

I have also attached to the bottom of this section our new Bible Verse that we had started to learn in school. The verse is from Micah and encourages us to be just and to show love and friendship to each other and to our God.

I hope you enjoy using these resources. The children always look forward to Worship each day (usually at 10.20am) and this could become a nice quiet reflection time for you and your family to enjoy together.
