

Spring 3 2021. Homeschooling Worship ideas

These are ideas for Worship, they loosely follow the plans in school but many of the books/stories we use are not available on the internet. We use the Lion Storyteller Bible a lot and this book has the most popular Bible stories in it. Please feel free to follow your own themes and sing your own choice of songs (find a selection of songs at the end). The children are very good at making up prayers and so your child or yourself could make one up each day. Please see the other Worship resources.

	Theme	Ideas
Week 1	Each day Different/Differences	<p>We are all different and should celebrate our differences. We are all good at different things. Think about all the things that you are good at and make a list. What is your friend/family good at. What things are different and what things are the same. Did you list things like being kind and thoughtful?</p> <p>Try out a new skill today - draw a picture, learn a new song, play a new game. Have fun trying out new things.</p> <p>Enter "stories about being different ks1" in the internet and lots of youtube stories will be there for you to listen to.</p>
Week 2	Winter	<p>A story of Saint Bernard</p> <p>The winter picnic by Jane Hissey</p> <p>Enter "stories about winter for ks1" in the internet and lots of youtube stories will be there for you to listen to. Discuss the importance of looking after the animals and checking on neighbours during the cold months. Make a bird feeder.</p>
Week 3	The Trinity	<p>What can you tell your grown up about the Trinity? Think about what we say when we open our Worship Box and also when we light the candles. Do you remember about Mrs Elks' three hats? If not then here is a quick reminder. Mrs Elks is one person but she has three hats for doing different things:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A sun hat for the sun, 2. A woolly hat for the cold, 3. A red floppy knitted hat for when she is pretending to be an Amazon (from her favourite story of "Swallows and Amazons".). <p>3 hats but 1 person, 3 in 1. This is a simple way of explaining that God is really 3 in 1 - God the Father, God the son and God the Holy Spirit.</p> <p>We sing the Trinity song to the tune of Frere Jacques</p> <p>For God the Father we like to tell the story of the Creation.</p>

		For God the son we like to tell a story about Jesus and the miracles he did. For God the Holy Spirit we tell the story of Ascension and the Holy Spirit coming back down to earth. We also talk about the Holy Spirit being like a little friend on our shoulder who is always with us, helping us to do the right things.
Week 4	Compassion	The good Samaritan. Compassion for the poor. Kind Dorcas https://www.kidsofintegrity.com/lessons/compassion/bible-stories
Week 5	Ministry of Jesus(Jesus' Job)	Spreading the Good News. The sower. Story of the 10 lepers. Any story of Jesus helping others.
Week 6	Ministry of Jesus(Jesus' Job)	Story about Jesus making the lame walk. Story about Jesus making the deaf hear. Any story of Jesus helping others e.g. helping the fisherman, washing the disciples feet before the last supper.

Week 1	Blossom and Bloom And books	Think about spring flowers. Plant some seeds and watch them grow. Choose a selection of your favourite stories from home/Bible to share together. Lots of stories have a moral so discuss what we can learn from the story.
Week 2	Book week	Choose a selection of your favourite stories from home/Bible to share together. Lots of stories have a moral so discuss what we can learn from the story.
Week 3	Trust. Mothering Sunday.	Trusting God/Jesus The storm on the sea- Jesus calming the water. Enter "stories about trust for ks1" in the internet and lots of youtube stories will be there for you to listen to. Make a card for your Mum or Dad or a friend ready for Sunday.
Week 4	Stories from the Bible (that we haven't heard yet)	Please choose your own or some suggestions below:- The lost coin The parable of the lost son - The prodigal son Jesus and the taxman - Zaccheus The two houses - built on the sand and the rock
Week 5	Easter. Holy Week.	Palm Sunday. Cheating in the temple.
