English (Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening) An English lesson will take place each day. A variety of activities including reading, writing and discussion based tasks will help the children to revise all of the concepts we have learned so far this year. In particular, children will be recapping over nouns, verbs, adverbs and adjectives. They will also be focusing on the four different types of sentences - statements, questions, commands and exclamations. The children will be doing some more work on their comprehension skills, including strengthening their inferencing. A weekly "Spelling, Punctuation And Grammar" (SPAG) lesson will take place with Mrs Elks. This will concentrate on more complex sentence structures.	Maths Children will be revising everything we have learned so far in readiness for our Puzzle Booklets (SATs). They will continue to start each lesson with a problem to solve. Children are being encouraged to draw pictures to help them to solve a problem. Maths terminology will be revised this half term for e.g. different words for add or take away. Areas that we will cover will include:- Place value Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division Missing number problems Shapes Time Measures fractions	Science In our Science lessons the children will be looking at famous UK athletes and thinking about the diet they have and the exercise they complete in order to train and make them fit and healthy. We will also be looking at the conditions a plant needs to thrive and children will be conducting an experiment to find out what these conditions are. Geography The children will be identifying the four countries and capitals of the United Kingdom using maps and globes. They will be recording the weather daily in their own weather diary. Finally they will be looking at aerial photos of London and identifying the human and physical features.
History Children will be learning about the History in their local area this term. In particular, the children will be learning about Sir Nigel Gresley and two of his most famous trains. The children will also be learning about The Great Fire of London.
