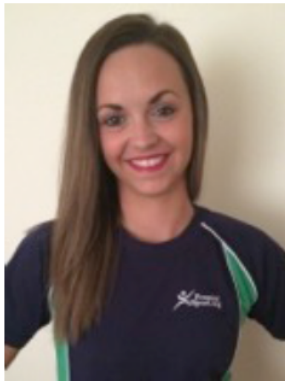
2015 - 2016 Academic Year
