Our Vision statement and Bible quotation truly drives our school and all that we do. The Vision statement was originally written with the help of pupils, parents, staff and governors. We aim to equip children with a vast array of experiences and opportunities to strengthen them to start their journey to build an 'abundant life'.

Our infant friendly strapline 'Flying High' is embedded within everything we do. The language 'Flying High' is used throughout the day and is displayed around the school. It reminds children to do their best, try hard, never give up and fly high to achieve their goals. The children are very familiar with this and will use the language modelled when talking to each other. The staff and children reward each other with 'Flying High' claps and during our weekly Awards Collective Worship we sing our school song 'Let's go Flying High', to the tune of 'Let's go fly a kite'.

Each year group is named after a bird (Swans, Robins and Swallows) reflecting the theme of flying high.

- To foster a lifelong love and respect for the environment through awe inspiring Forest School sessions which develop resilient, confident, independent and creative learners.


# 'Do be Values' and 'British Values'
