We have a strategic role within the School. We are not involved in the day-to-day management of the school, this is the responsibility of the Headteacher and her staff. We are expected to play the part of a 'critical friend'. This means striking the right balance between challenge and support. In this role we question and suggest refinements to the proposals and policies of the School. We are involved in appointing staff and dealing with any matters which could involve appeals and we are responsible for the School Budget. We keep abreast of current developments in education through the Derbyshire County Council governor training briefings. We have also completed a skills audit within the Governing Body and ensured that Governors are allocated to appropriate committees.

We have reviewed safeguarding issues in the school.

The parents' questionnaire has been reviewed, with very positive results. As a result of the responses, we are investigating the possibilities of before school care, although recognise this is difficult in a school of our size.

Attendance has been monitored; this was found to be lower than pre-Covid but is now recovering to expected levels.

We recognise that there are ongoing issues surroundings the Covid-19 pandemic, including school closure during November 2021. We will continue to follow government and local guidelines.

The Resources Committee has set the school budget and monitored projected pupil numbers.

We have been involved in the setting of the school improvement plan which focuses on the further development of good teaching in the school, increasing the level of challenge for the more able in lessons.

Phonics has been, and continues to be, a focus in school. We have received detailed information on the new Phonics scheme, which is being implemented in school.

The new Pre-School building has been completed and preschool pupils are enjoying their new surroundings. School facilities continue to be updated; this year we replaced pupil toilets.

All committees have read and approved a wide range of school policies.
